**November 26, Constitution Day: Some Reflections**

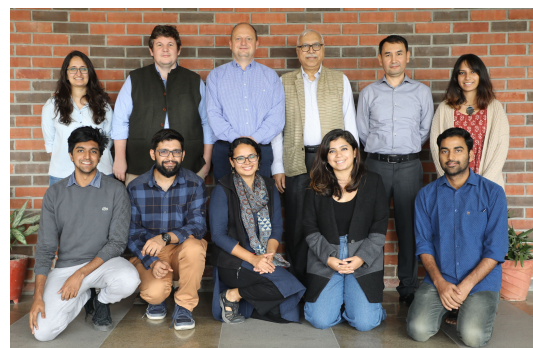

Assembly, the Committee on Fundamental Rights recognized the independence and non-interference by the executive and legislature in the elections a fundamental right.

The execution of Article 324 bore its fruit in the form of Election Commission of India, which was established on 25th January 1950 - a day before India became a sovereign democratic republic. At the outset, I would like to congratulate the Bengal Vidhan Sabha, Honorable Speaker, Honorable Chief Minister. and Honorable members of the house for celebrating this momentous occasion, the 70th Constitution Day!

26th November marks a very important milestone in independent India's history. On this day in 1949, India adopted its Constitution after the members of the constituent assembly worked hard for two years, eleven months and seventeen days. The zeal with which they participated in materializing this idea called the Constitution of India is reflected in the fact that they proposed as many as 7,635 amendments to the draft. And finally, amidst loud cheers and music of national anthem echoing in the Parliament, the founding fathers of the constitution gave the nation its sacred book, comprising 395 articles and 8 schedules.

On this day, sixteen Articles came into effect including Article 324 which laid the foundation for the establishment Election Commission mandated with "superintendence, direction and control" of all elections. During proceedings of the
